We continue to invest in quality and security around the management of our data. We successfully earned HITRUST Risk-Based, r2 Certification, one of the most distinguished recognitions in data security and privacy. Another monumental achievement was supporting 333 of our members with achieving or maintaining their NCQA Data Aggregator Validation Accreditation, showcasing our dedication to delivering high quality, reliable and actionable clinical data.

Public Health remains central to our mission. We successfully implemented an MDRO Alerting Pilot Project in partnership with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KPHE). This project, along with the launch of our real-time notification product, RapidAlerts Direct, have transformed the way we manage patient information and care coordination.

Another important initiative was the launch of HQ Insights-Birth Connect, aimed at improving health outcomes for mothers and newborns. This, coupled with the launch of the HQ Insights-Behavioral Health Dashboards in partnership with SacValley MedShare, demonstrates our commitment to aligning physical and behavioral health and promoting improved health outcomes and health equity.

As we look forward to 2024, I am confident that we will continue to innovate and drive positive change in the healthcare industry. Your support and dedication have been instrumental in our success, and I am truly grateful. Together, let's continue to make a difference in the lives of those we serve.

Achievements and Milestones

Qualified Health Information Network (QHIN)

KONZA emerged as one of the premier organizations to be named a QHIN, a recognition that underscores our persistent pursuit of innovation in health information exchange. Throughout 2023, we prioritized the onboarding process, ensuring seamless integration of diverse healthcare systems into a unified, interoperability network on a national scale.

HITRUST Risk-Based, r2 Certification

In a significant stride towards data security and risk management, KONZA achieved the rigorous HITRUST Risk-Based, r2 Certification in 2023. This certification stands as a testament to our commitment to maintaining the highest standards of data protection and privacy. It provides assurance to our partners and stakeholders that we are adhering to the most stringent industry standards and best practices.

NCQA Data Aggregator Validation (DAV) Accreditation

Our dedication to quality and accuracy in data aggregation has led to 333 of our members achieving or maintaining their NCQA Data Aggregator Validation (DAV) Accreditation in 2023. This achievement demonstrates our commitment to delivering robust and reliable clinical data that drives informed decision-making and improved patient outcomes.

RapidAlerts Direct: Flexible Information Sharing

We introduced RapidAlerts Direct, a real-time notification product designed to improve care coordination and reduce patient risks. This simple system delivers critical health information in real-time, facilitating prompt and informed decisions by healthcare professionals.

MDRO Pilot Project

In collaboration with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDPHE), KONZA successfully implemented an MDRO alerting pilot project. This initiative involved developing an alerting system for patients diagnosed with Multi-Drug Resistant Organisms (MDROs), ensuring swift and effective response measures to control the spread of such infections.

HQ Insights-Birth Connect

In 2023, KONZA launched HQ Insights-Birth Connect, a birth alert solution aimed at making data more actionable. With timely birth alerts, the data points in Birth Connect provide clinicians with critical care coordination information. This tool aids in timely access to key clinical quality metrics and helps with the early identification and management of potential health risks to support mother and infant in the early stages of life.

HQ Insights-Behavioral Health Dashboards with SacValley MedShare

In partnership with SacValley MedShare, KONZA launched HQ Insights-Behavioral Health Dashboards. These dashboards are designed to align physical and behavioral health, meeting California's Behavioral Health Quality Improvement Program (BHQIP) requirements. They leverage data from diverse care sites, providing clinicians with actionable insights to inform patient care. The dashboards promote improved health outcomes and health equity by facilitating focused and informed care coordination based on near real-time longitudinal clinical data.

RapidAlerts Direct Windsor Place

Windsor Place, a long-term care organization in Kansas, has been using RapidAlerts Direct to be notified if their patients have had an emergency department or hospital inpatient visit. Prior to RapidAlerts Direct, the care managers were performing manual queries—sometimes daily—to monitor their patient population.

CareAlign Pratt Family Practice

Advanced payment models reward Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs) for delivering high-quality care and closing care gaps for members to earn shared savings and increase profits. To meet ACO Quality Measures, a practice must rely on high quality data. Pratt Family Practice, an ACO in Kansas, had been requesting a patient's records from Veterans Affairs, but unfortunately, they were unable to locate accurate files. Finally, working with KONZA, they utilized CareAlign to successfully locate the patient's records to close the gaps in care and improve their ACO Quality Measures performance and reporting accuracy.

"I had been requesting records from the VA since September to close care gaps on a patient, and while I received records in return, they were incorrect. I resubmitted the request multiple times, but to no avail. Thanks to KONZA, I was able to find the correct records by using CareAlign and close the care gaps, thereby improving our ACO Quality Measures."

Multidrug-Resistant Organism (MDRO) Alerts Newman Regional Health

A Critical Access Hospital in Emporia, KS, Newman Regional Health was the first pilot site to go live using RapidAlerts Direct to notify care coordination staff of incoming patients who have an active MDRO diagnosis. Using RapidAlerts Direct, staff can implement swift and effective response measures to control the spread of MDRO infections.

"RapidAlerts Direct could be transformative for infection control measures. The real-time alerts allow for immediate implementation of isolation and transmission-based protocols. This has significantly improved our ability to contain infections in a critical time frame and thus prevent MDRO disease spread to other patients and staff in our facilities. The ability to use RapidAlerts allows us to continue to provide high quality care to our patients and community."

HQ Insights Eureka Clinic, Greenwood County Hospital

The Eureka Clinic is part of a small Critical Access Hospital, which serves rural Greenwood County in Kansas. The hospital adopted the use of HQ Insights to manage their Transitions of Care program to improve patient care and outcomes.
